4.5. Does not contain words written in all capital letters, acronyms, references to the cited literature, and abbreviations.

6.2. Citations are identified by Arabic numerals listed in ascending order enclosed in brackets.  Ex: Studies show that diabetes increases the risk of developing vascular diseases, such as myocardial infarction and stroke [1-4].			
6.3. Direct quotations are enclosed in quotation marks, within the body of the text, and contain the page number for reference.

7.1.List of references was written using the <b>Vancouver</b> reference style.

8.12. The acronyms and abbreviations used in the illustrations were explained in full in the illustration legend or footnote.		
8.13. In the event of use, adaptation, or translation of illustrations and/or any other intellectual work published in other sources, a written permission is included and the source is adequately cited.		
8.14. In the event of use third-party material, such as photographs, a written permission from all persons in the photographs is included.
